7:20pm Meeting called to order

Old Business

- Mike Dikes covered October tournament results and Year to Date standings.
- Open tournament held, club made \$260

New Business

- There were no new club officer volunteers. The Executive Board agreed to stay on for another year.
 - Leif Neely announced that he is likely to move out of state in the very near future, which would cause him to vacate the Vice President seat. Jeff Stevens volunteered to take over this position in the event that Leif has to leave.
- Mike Dikes called for rule change suggestions.
 - Shawn Moore made a motion that the Top 10 finishers will be the only qualifiers for the championship tournament, with no minimum requirement of meeting or tournament attendance to qualify. If any of the Top 10 is unable to fish the championship they will still be entitled to their portion of the split. There will be no movement of #11 or # 12 into the championship tournament due to an absence of a Top 10 individual.
 - Justin Shaffer seconded
 - Motion carried unanimously.

- Justin Shaffer made a motion that only 5 fish will be weighed per boat, and both members of that team get the weight toward their YTD standings.
 - Jimmy Erwin seconded
 - Motion carried unanimously
 - Side note – there will still be 1 lb earned for each meeting attended and another 1 lb earned for participation in a tournament.
- There was general discussion of the Big Bass Rule. There will only be one place paid for Big Bass per boat, 1st and 2nd place cannot be paid to the same boat.
- Shawn Moore made a motion that the club revert back to TPW state regulations. There will not be a 14” minimum on Spotted Bass.
 - Mike Dikes seconded
 - Motion carried unanimously
